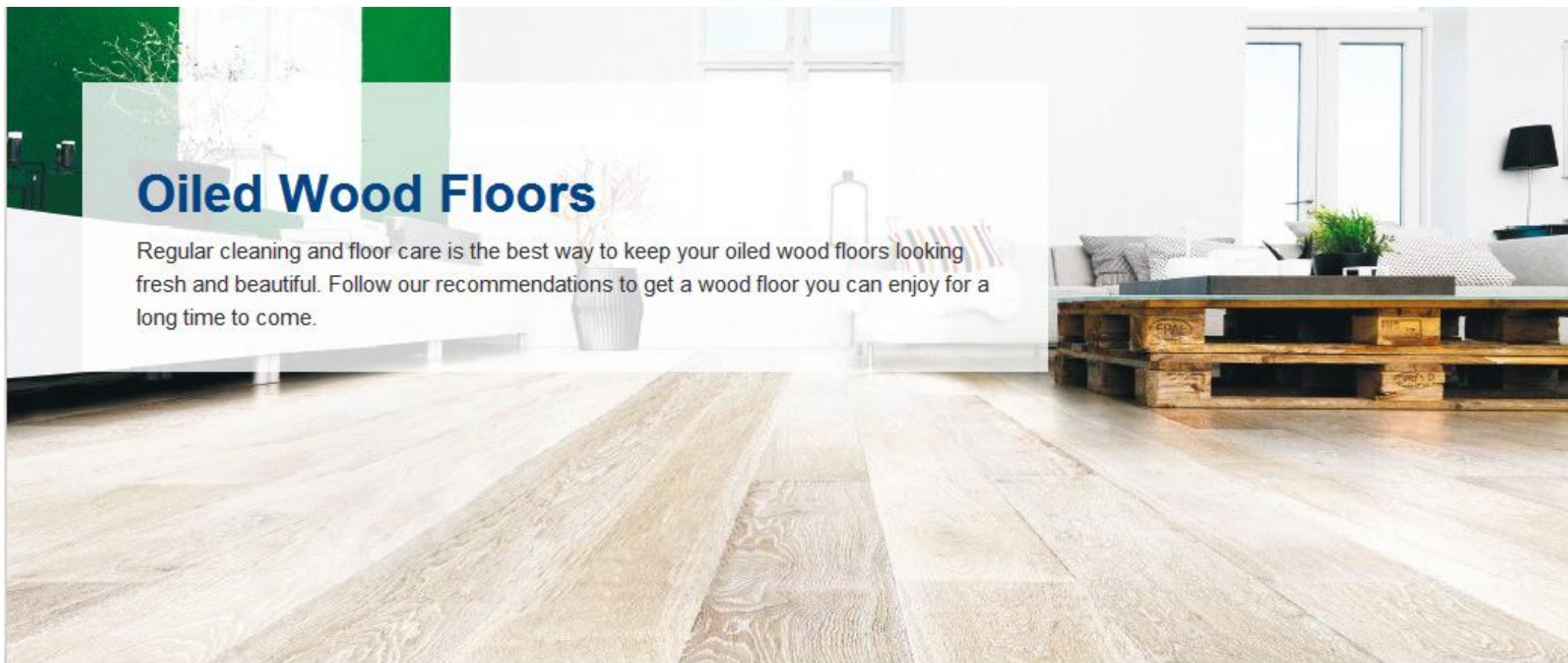


Oiled Wood Floors

Regular cleaning and floor care is the best way to keep your oiled wood floors looking fresh and beautiful. Follow our recommendations to get a wood floor you can enjoy for a long time to come.



About wood oil

Treatment with wood oil is very popular as it brings out the same beautiful look that many exotic wood species have. Wood floors treated with oil bring out the wood's natural character and warmth. Wood oil doesn't give any direct protection against wear but helps to repel water. It's a good idea to think about which rooms are suitable for oiled wood floors.

It can be difficult to see and feel the difference between an oiled wood floor and a waxed wood floor. A waxed wood floor is softer and a little more slippery than oiled wood floors.

Cleaning

Things to think about when you clean your oiled wood floor:

- ✓ Protecting your oiled floors is simple. By routinely cleaning, you remove dust and dirt before they scratch and dull the surface, or wear away the floor.
- ✓ Always keep water to a minimum when cleaning your oiled wood floors. If you spill (food or drinks), wipe up immediately to prevent any permanent damage or staining.
- ✓ Sweep or vacuum your oiled floors as often as needed. Use our Bona Microfiber Dusting Pad to remove dust and grit that act like sandpaper to damage the floor's surface. Then use Bona's mild, specially formulated Cleaner For Oiled Floors. Just spray and wipe!
- ✓ Do not use "all-purpose" cleaners on your oiled floors as they tend to leave a dull residue and you end up using too much water, which is damaging to your oiled floors.

Maintaining

Things to think about when you maintain your oiled wood floor:

- ✓ Use a special oil product for maintaining and protecting your oiled floors such as Bona's specially formulated Refresher for Oiled floors to be sure you keep your floors looking great.
- ✓ If you have laid an oiled floor in an area where there is a high risk of spilling water, like in a kitchen, apply Bona Oil Refresher to add a layer of protection and increase the life of your new floors.
- ✓ The oil refresher can be applied as needed but usually a few times a year. Always make sure the wood floor is cleaned before re-applying.

Cleaner for Oiled Floors



Bona Cleaner for Oiled Floors is an easy, safe, and effective cleaner for oiled wooden floors. Cleans and nourishes the surface and increases the protection.

Preparations

Vacuum floor before wet cleaning to ensure that dirt and grit is removed.

Application

1. Mist cleaner on a small section of the floor.
2. Wipe off floor section using a Bona Cleaning Pad. Rinse or replace cleaning pad when soiled.

On stubborn spots, rubber heel marks or sticky spills etc, spray cleaner directly onto spot and let work a few minutes. Scrub spot clean with a cleaning pad.



Oil Refresher



Bona Oil Refresher makes the maintenance of oiled and hard-waxed oiled wood floors easy. Simply spray and wipe the floor – no machine buffing is required.

Through reinforced polyurethane Bona Oil Refresher offers durable protection and gives new luster to dull oiled floors. Bona Oil Refresher is an environmentally sound product with low solvent content.

Important!

Always test floors for adhesion and desired results prior to use. Do not use on previously waxed floors. Ensure normal room temperature 18-25°C.

KEY BENEFITS

- Waterborne
- Easy to use, just spray and mop – no heavy machines are required
- No buffing needed
- Touch-up possible
- Short drying time. Floor can be used again in only 2 hours.
- Low VOC (Volatile Organic Compounds) and free from cobalt

Preparations

Remove loose dirt and grit from your floor. Clean floor thoroughly with Bona Wood Floor Cleaner and let dry. Do not use over any floor that has been treated with soft wax. Wax residues may produce an uneven sheen. **If uncertain, perform a small test before use.**

Shake bottle thoroughly before use and apply at normal room temperature, 18-25°C.

Application

1. Dampen a Bona Cleaning Pad with Bona Oil Refresher
2. Spray Oil Refresher onto a small section of the floor and distribute the product with the Cleaning Pad. Work in the direction of the wood.
3. Continue section by section until the whole floor has been treated.

The floor can be walked on already after 2 hours but avoid heavy traffic and replacement of furniture and rugs the first 12 hours.

Bona Soap



Detergent based on vegetable oil for frequent cleaning and maintenance of oiled wooden floors. Bona soap nourishes the surface and leaves a thin film that can be buffed for increased shine.

KEY BENEFITS

- Gentle on oiled surfaces
- Cleans and conditions
- Long lasting concentrate

Preparations

Remove loose dust/grit etc using a vacuum cleaner, scissor mop or other dry cleaning method. Shake the container well and dissolve 0.2 litre Bona Soap in 10 litres of water.

Application

Clean along the grain using a well wrung-out cloth, mop or similar. On heavily soiled floors a buffing machine with a nylon pad can be run in the wet soap solution. Use a red pad on pigmented floors and a green pad on floors with regular, clear oil. Pick up the dissolved dirt with a mop directly.

When surface has dried it can be dry buffed for more shine. Best results are obtained using a buffing machine (300 rpm) equipped with a Bona WoolPad.

Wood flooring should never be left damp, not to mention wet, over a prolonged period of time since they can absorb water and lose their shape or become discoloured. Always clean using as dry methods as possible and never pool the floor with water or cleaning solution. Take special care if the floor has open gaps. Do not allow liquid to seep freely into open gaps.

Bona Wax Oil Refresher



Bona Wax Oil Refresher is a maintenance product primarily for Bona Hard Wax Oil. It consists of a concentrate of natural oils and waxes and contains less than 2% solvents. Can also be used on Bona Craft Oil, where increased protection against water and spills is required.

KEY BENEFITS

- Quick drying
- Very low in solvents (<2%) and odour>
- Highly water repellent



Preparations

If necessary, the previously oiled/hard wax oiled surface must be thoroughly cleaned using Bona Soap or the Bona Deep Clean System and allowed to dry before applying Bona Wax Oil Refresher. Allow product to reach room temperature and shake the container thoroughly before use. **Minimum temperature for use is 16°C.**

Application

1. Apply the Wax Oil Refresher thinly using a Bona WoolPad or a stainless steel trowel.
2. Remove surplus Wax Oil Refresher with cotton cloths straightaway and let dry min 12 h, expect longer drying time on exotic wood and at low temperatures.

WARNING: BONA WAX OIL REFRESHER CONTAINS DRYING OILS. RISK OF SELF-IGNITION. USED CLOTHS, RAGS AND SIMILAR SHOULD BE PLACED IN WATER OR SEALED METAL CONTAINERS.

Maintenance

Clean the floor regularly using a dry mop and/or a vacuum cleaner. When needed, wipe off with a damp mop with Bona Soap added to the cleaning water. Always clean using as dry a method as possible. Apply Bona Wax Oil Refresher frequently to ensure that the pores of the surface remain saturated and unable to pick up dirt and moisture. The frequency of this operation is determined by the level of wear and may range from every 3rd year in a domestic environment to a few times a year in a commercial setting.
