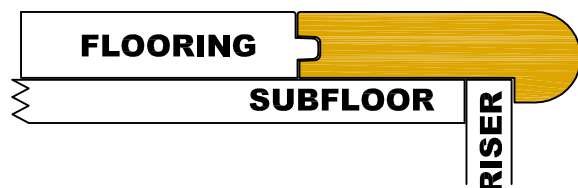


MOLDINGS FOR HARDWOOD FLOOR INSTALLATION GUIDE

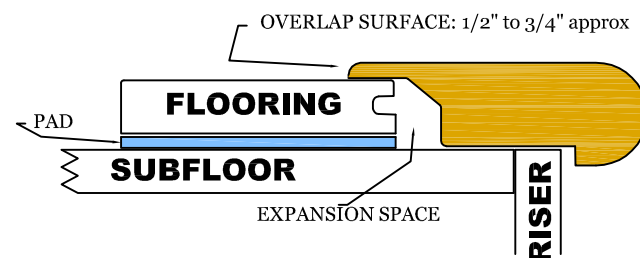
STANDARD STAIRNOSING



Stairnosing transitions floor to edge of stair to provide a finished trim.

For use as a stair landings trim, elevated floor perimeters and stair steps.

OVERLAP STAIRNOSING



Overlap Stairnosings/moldings are milled to allow the "lip" to ride up over the top of the flooring; used primarily with floating floor applications.

Choose the right size for the flooring height:

Pennwood Products offers stairnosing moldings in either a tongue and groove configuration, flush mount or overlap for floating installations. Because there are variances in thickness with some manufacturer's hardwood floors, the tongue and groove configuration is match to the flooring to prevent breakage after the molding is installed.
