Storage and Handling Instructions

Consult SDS. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not mix with other chemicals. Do not release to natural waterways.

- Inhalation: In high concentrations, vapors may be irritating to the respiratory system. If irritation occurs, remove person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Seek medical attention if any discomfort continues.

5. INSTALLATION

Surface Preparation

Read entire label before using. Use only as directed.

Avoid skin and eye contact with product. Wear protective eyewear, gloves, long sleeves, and long pants while handling concentrate. Ensure work area is well-ventilated during application and until surface is dry to the touch. Keep children and pets out of the area during application and drying. Do not freeze or store above 100°F/38°C.

Directions

During Grout Clean-Up

- 1. Clean-up residual grout according to the grout manufacturer's instructions.
- 2. Dilute 1 part STONETECH Grout Haze Remover with 8 parts water.
- For the final grout removal wipe-down and rinse, wet a grout sponge or clean towel with STONETECH Grout Haze Remover cleaning solution and wring out.
- 4. Wipe the dampened sponge/towel diagonally across the surface to be cleaned. Rinse and wring out sponge/towel regularly.
- 5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 as necessary.
- 6. Using a clean grout sponge and/or cloth towel, remove remaining cleaning solution.

Post Grout Clean-Up

- 1. After 72 hours dilute 1 part STONETECH Grout Haze Remover with 4 parts water if grout haze was not completely removed during the initial clean-up. After 7 days, use product full strength but do not leave product on surface for more than 10 minutes.
- Apply directly to the surface to be cleaned and lightly rub with a scrub brush or white nylon pad. To facilitate use, product can be sprayed directly onto problem areas. Do not use a power sprayer to apply product.
- 3. Remove product using a clean sponge, mop or wet/dry vacuum.
- 4. Rinse area well with clean water and dry.
