Storage and Handling Instructions

5. INSTALLATION

Surface Preparation for Ready to use spray bottle

Read entire label before using. Use only as directed. Always test in a small inconspicuous area to determine ease of use and desired results. Make sure all surfaces to be cleaned are swept or vacuumed to remove loose debris.

Directions for Ready-to-use spray bottle

1. Spray directly on soiled area. Avoid applying onto unintended surfaces.
2. Scrub with a clean, non-abrasive sponge or stiff nylon brush as needed.
3. Remove STONETECH® Heavy Duty Tile & Grout Cleaner using a clean dry towel, sponge or mop.
4. Rinse area well with clean water.
5. Reseal cleaned area.

Surface Preparation for Concentrate

Read entire label before using. Use only as directed. Always test in a small inconspicuous area to determine ease of use and desired results. Be sure all surfaces to be cleaned are swept or vacuumed to remove loose debris. Avoid skin and eye contact with product. Wear protective eyewear, gloves, long sleeves, and long pants while handling concentrate. Ensure work area is well-ventilated during application and until surface is dry. Keep children and pets out of the area during application and drying.

DIRECTIONS for Concentrate

1. Dilute concentrated cleaner with warm water according to the following mixing chart:

Use	STONETECH® Heavy Duty Tile & Grout Cleaner	Warm Water	pH
Heavy Duty	1 part	2 parts	11.3
Spray Refill	1 part	4 parts	11.0
Light Duty	1 part	8 parts	10.7
Acid Neutralizer	1 part	16 parts	10.5

2. Apply mixed solution with a mop, clean cloth or sprayer. Avoid applying cleaner on unintended surfaces.
3. Lightly rub with a scrub brush or floor machine as needed.
4. Remove STONETECH® Tile & Grout Cleaner using a clean cloth, wet/dry vacuum or damp mop.
5. Rinse area well with clean water.
6. Reseal cleaned area with a STONETECH sealer
