Weaber Nickel Gap Shiplap

Installation Instructions

- 1. Supply List: safety glasses, tape measure, pencil, stud finder, chalk line, level, nails, nail gun, jigsaw, miter saw, wood filler, paint, shiplap
- 2. If needed, remove all artwork, mouldings, outlet covers and switch plates from your walls.
- 3. Using a stud finder, mark the location of your studs for nailing guidelines.
- 4. Using your level, strike a guideline to keep your shiplap level.
- 5. Beginning at the base of your wall, mark a quarter inch spacer up from your floor. This is where you will begin installation.
- 6. Place your first board at the quarter inch spacer mark. Insert 2 nails vertically on the face of the board at the stud guidelines until it is secure.
- 7. Lineup your next board above the first. It will overlap the first board with a 1/4" gap.
- 8. Remember to make allowances for outlets, windows, and doors. A jigsaw with a guide is recommended for clean edges.
- 9. Continue installation until your wall is complete.
- 10. Attach mouldings, fill nail holes, and touch up with paint.
- 11. Enjoy your new wall finish.
